## **Institutional Review Board FAQs**

All research that involves human subjects, whether funded or not, that is undertain by a WIU faculty member academic staff or studieor supported by Western Ilinois University, must be reviewed by the WIU Institutional Review Board (RB). Approval must be granted by the IRB prior toollecting data from any human subjects for eseach purposes or soliciting subjects for a research study.

## Helpful Tips for Conducting Human Subjects Research

- 1. Protocols for review need to befully completed with all supporting docuentation, mateial, consent and/or cover letter needed o complete the stdy. Failure to turn in complete a protoc may deay approval. Exempt an expedited reviews normally take 7-10 days for review, while the full review process may take up to 30 day.
- 2. Avoid discipline specific jargon in the IRB protocol and informed consent. Documents and materials should be written so that an individual with limited education in the field can easily read and understand yours reach pupose.
- 3. A faculty or staff member must serve as therefore investigator (PI) on any seach project conducted by a student. This includes all graduate and undergraduate dependent, heses, o dissertations.
- 4. Informed consent dougnents need to includeontat information for thePI (e-mai, office phone) and the Compliance Speialist (309-298-1191 dlRB@wiu.edu). In addion, a statement describing the amount of risinvolved must be included. If a Tw 1 0p
